### IDEAL FOR ENGINES STARTING UP TO 350 HP

The Marine Pro 600 has sufficient reserve capacity to operate 'Basic Electrics' and 'Optional Electrics'. If more than 2 Optional Electrics are fitted to the boat, a Dual Battery system (Marine Pro battery and a Deep Cycle battery) is recommended.

Century Marine Pro Batteries are specially designed to handle the rigours of pounding from heavy seas. Car batteries are not suitable for Marine use. Safety is very important when out on the water.

The heavy power needs of some Optional Electrics may require the additional support of a Dual Battery System, which includes a Deep Cycle battery. For information on Dual Battery Systems, and calculating the correct power needs of your boat, ask your Century representative for the Deep Cycle battery brochure.
